Fees have been calculated to ensure recovery of a range of club operating costs, including field hire, coaching, umpiring, administration, trophies and subscriptions, as well as delivery of a range of Club Programs. Fees do not take into account costs associated with most events and presentations; these are covered by the ticketing associated with the events.

A way to reduce your fees is to assist the club with coaching and umpiring. Players that coach a junior team receive a discount against their fees.

Umpires that perform Club allocations are also paid for each commitment. More information will be provided in the coming weeks.


Our website provides a lot of information and the St Pats history, and the club sends club-wide information out via email from time to time. Managers will also send team specific information to players as needed.
