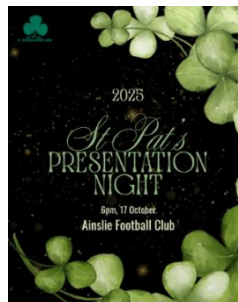
Friday 17 October - arrive from 6.00pm for a 6.30pm start
